On a hot summer afternoon—Monday, July 15, 1929— using a borrowed microphone, the first broadcast of what would become known as *Music & the Spoken Word* originated from the Tabernacle on Temple Square in Salt Lake City, Utah. From that humble beginning has come the oldest, continuous network program in broadcast history. *Music & the Spoken Word* features the world-renowned Tabernacle Choir and Orchestra at Temple Square performing spiritual, patriotic, popular, classical and contemporary music. The program is a musical masterpiece that millions of loyal viewers and listeners eagerly return to every week.






